II Corinthians 9:12-13



I entered the rooms of AA and found a new way of life through accountability and honesty with other men that allowed me to stay sober for 7 years. After 7 years of sobriety, I decided to return to drinking because I had stopped doing the things that

had kept me sober and I had denied the need for a savior. In 2006 I entered the program at Dunklin Memorial Church and on Oct 17th of that year I gave my life to Christ and started this journey of faith. My life was radically changed, and I fell in love with the Lord. Through God's grace and mercy my family was restored, and I committed my life at the time to work in full time ministry at Dunklin. Due to my immaturity and selfish ambitions I decided to take my family out of the amazing community that had given us so much to pursue what I thought was more. This led to relapse and losing the most. Before returning to

Dunklin in 2020 I had multiple suicide attempts, incarcerations and baker acts due to the insanity of walking away from the calling the Lord had on my life. I am grateful to Dunklin and Joshua's Promise Ministries for standing with me and providing a place for me to call home.
